- The Harker property is located on the Destor-Porcupine Fault.
- The Destor-Porcupine Fault is the most prolific fault of the Abitibi Greenstone Belt.
- The Abitibi Greenstone Belt is the most prolific mining belt in the world. More than 300 gold and base metal mines discovered and exploited for the last 100 years with the famous Canadian mining camps (Noranda, Val-d'Or, Kirkland Lake, Matagami, Timmins, Matheson). It is more than 80 millions ounces already produced in Timmins only.
- Timmins-Matheson produced over 80 million ounces of gold.
- Two producing gold mines contiguous to the Harker Property.

- 50% of the dd holes returned economic gold values (1.5 meter grading 5 g).
- gold zone proven by drilling over 250 meters and down 225 meters with a tight grid pattern.
- gold mineralization discovered in 2010 over an additional 200 meters not yet investigated by diamond drilling.
- only 1 claim already explored out of 20 claims for Harker.
